I want to east my personal contacts.

You can create and edit a list of frequently used contacts. The contacts are stored only on your SwyxPhone. All entries are listed in alphabetical order.

 \rightarrow Press the \square Navigation key.

The "Directory" appears, a list of your personal contacts.

Add contact

- \rightarrow Select "Directory | New Entry" and confirm with the Enter key.
- → Enter the name and phone number(s) of the contact. Use the "Save" function key to confirm that the information is correct.
- \rightarrow You can assign a particular call signal to the contact. Select the CLIP Melody and use the Navigation key to assign the required ringtone.
- \rightarrow Press the "Save" function key, to save the new contact.

Edit contact

- \rightarrow Select the required contact and confirm with the Enter key.
- \rightarrow Press the "Edit" function key.
- \rightarrow Edit the name or the number, and confirm the changes with the "Save" function key to save the changes.

Delete contact

- \rightarrow Select the required contact and confirm with the Enter key.
- \rightarrow Press the "Options" function key and then "Delete enrty".
- \rightarrow Press the Enter key to delete the contact.

The contact is deleted and no longer appears in the list.

Edit number before call

You can edit a number before making a call; for example, if you want to add a project code.

- → Select the required contact, press the "Options" function key and select "Display number".
- \rightarrow Add the required numbers/characters and press the \bigwedge key.
- \rightarrow Press the function key \rightarrow in order to save the edited number in your directory.

Add contact to a speed dial key

- \rightarrow Select a number key and hold down.
- → Select the required contact from your open directory and confirm with the "OK" function key.
- → To carry out speed dialing, hold down the speed dial key of the required contact until the call starts.

17 Call contacts from the Global Phonebook

SwyxPhone D750 provides access to the Global Phonebook.

- \rightarrow Press the left navigation key INT
 - The Global Phonebook opens.
- \rightarrow Press the "Options" function key and then "Detail search".
- \rightarrow Confirm with the "OK" function key.
- ightarrow Enter one or more letters of the desired subscriber's first name or surname.
- ightarrow Press the "Search" function key.
- A list of subscribers appears.
- ightarrow Use the navigation key to select the required subscriber and press []
 - A list of all numbers assigned to the subscriber will appear.
- → Use the navigation key to select the required number and press The call is initiated.

18 Listening to voice mails

If there are new voicemails for you, the **oo** icon appears on the display.

- \rightarrow Hold down the key until the voicemail inquiry call starts.
- \rightarrow Follow the Remote Inquiry menu instructions.

Note: Your call forwarding must be configured for Remote Inquiry in this case. For further information, please refer to the SwyxIt! documentation.

Additional functions

Select number from the caller list

- → Press the Enter key and select "Caller lists" conthe function key "Calls". A list of the dialed, missed, and answered calls is displayed. The different calls types are distinguished by the following symbols:
 - incoming call \checkmark , outgoing call \checkmark , and missed call \checkmark
- \rightarrow Use the navigation key to choose the number or name you want, and press the function key \square .

Activate/deactivate acoustic call signaling

- ightarrow To deactivate acoustic call signals permanently, hold down the [A] key until
 - the 🐹 icon appears on the display.
- A call is only signaled by the vibrator (see also Switch vibrator on/off).
- \rightarrow To unmute the microphone, press the 4 key again.
- \rightarrow When you hear the ring tone, press the "Silent" function key briefly to mute the phone temporarily. The phone will ring again on the next call.

Silent charging

→To deactivate acoustic call signals only during charging, select in the main menu "Settings | Audio Settings | Ring tones | Silent Charging" and confirm with the "Change" function key.

Search contacts during an active call

You are making a call.

- \rightarrow Press the **II** function key.
- → The "Directory" appears. You can search and see now your contacts with the navigation keys.

- → Select in the main menu "Settings | Audio Settings | Handset Volume" and confirm with the "OK" function key.
- \rightarrow Use the navigation key to set the volume you want.
- \rightarrow Press the "Save" function key to confirm the setting.

Change the ring volume

- → Select in the main menu "Settings | Audio Settings | Ringtones (Handset) | Volume" and confirm with the "OK" function key.
- \rightarrow Use the navigation key to set the volume you want.
- \rightarrow Press the "OK" function key to confirm the setting.

Ring tone

- → Select in the main menu "Settings | Audio Settings | Ringtones (Handset) | Melodies" and confirm with the "OK" function key.
- \rightarrow Use the navigation key to select the required call signal.
- \rightarrow Press the "Save" function key to confirm the setting.

Switch vibrator on/off

→ Select in the main menu "Settings | Audio Settings | Vibration" and confirm with the "Change" function key.

You can switch the vibrator on or off permanently, or set it so that it is triggered at the same time as or prior to acoustic call signaling.

Note: These changes will only be saved permanently for the profile "Personal".

Note: If you switch off the vibrator permanently, and acoustic call signaling is off, a call is only signaled by the display on the screen.

Language selection

→ In the main menu, select "Settings | Language", followed by the required language and confirm with the function key "Select". The user language is changed.
